**REFLECTION:** When Jesus spoke of himself as "the living bread come down from heaven", he gave great problems of understanding to his hearers, but he does not compromise and goes on to affirm that those who eat his flesh and drink his blood live in him and he in them. This is our Holy Communion. In Hebrew the word "to say" is the same as the word "to do", so when Jesus says those words of Consecration at the Last Supper "this is my Body, this is my Blood" he means exactly what he says literally.

<u>This week</u> the Prayers of our Liturgy, Mass and Divine Office are all from the Eleventh Week of the Year except.:

Fri.19th. Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: We honour the Heart of Jesus, pierced by the soldier's lance and the witness of those standing by that blood and water flowed out from this wound. Jesus gave his life in the way he prayed at the Last Supper, "This is my Body broken for you, this is my Blood poured out for you", the fulfilment of the Mission entrusted to him by the Father. This is true love Sat. 20th. The Immaculate Heart of Mary: Mary, like us had to grow in faith from the moment of the Annunciation, to her astonishment at the story the shepherds told, to how she wondered about Simeon's words at the door of the Temple and how she did not understand her 12 year old son in that same Temple. These words in the Gospel could only have been revealed by Our Lady. They offer us an insight into her journey of Faith as the mother of Jesus, the Mother of our God.



## **PARISH NEWS**

I would love to give you clearer knowledge of when we look to be back to normal but I have no idea when this will be. Our hope is that we will open for private prayer soon then Mass with reduced congregations and finally normality. I have not forgotten our young

people due to receive Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. You will be our priority so keep praying, preparing and shout out to our God to take this Virus away.


