The Bishops of Scotland have made the decision to suspend all Public Masses on Sundays and Weekdays till further notice. It is a sad but necessary situation. Our Churches will all remain open for private prayer and the Sacrament of Penance. Baptisms, Marriages and Funerals can be celebrated but with only immediate family and close friends present.

The Bishops ask us to follow Mass through the Internet or on Social Media. The Diocesan Media Group Sancta Familia will be offering us this opportunity and I also recommend Mass being relayed live from Knock Shrine at 12noon and 7pm each day on the web-site of the Shrine. This is a time too to return to the importance of family prayer and on this Sunday, Mother's Day, for all families in Scotland to pray the Rosary at 12noon for the protection of our families and that the spread of this Virus can be halted.

During Lent I ask all parishioners to pray for our young people preparing to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in June. Unfortunately because of present health restrictions we have to cancel our Monday workshops. I thank the Spiritans for their support and hope to complete them when things improve.

I thank Lorraine Cunningham for her contribution to helping us understand the work of SCIAF and the special areas of their work with women who have suffered much yet still yearn for a better future for themselves and their children. These projects will be the main beneficiaries of your financial support this Lent.

THIS SUNDAY the special Lenten Collection for SCIAF is due and once again I ask you to be generous to a fault in your giving. Baskets will be at the Church entrance to make your offering and you can also hand it in at Parish House. The work of SCIAF is also supported by the income from the “WEE BOX”. There are still some available at the Church Door so please take one home today.

The Parish still depends on your generosity during this time for the usual upkeep and expenses of the Parish. Again when you make a visit to the Church during these difficult times please place your offerings in the Box marked for this purpose.

First Reconciliation this Tuesday 24th March, is cancelled. A new date will be fixed once the course of this present Virus crisis can be predicted.

First Communion scheduled to take place on Saturday 16th May at 12.00noon with our Thanksgiving Mass and Procession on Sunday 17th May at 11.00am. It looks likely with the spread of Corona Virus and the closure of our School they may need to be re-arranged. With this uncertainty around I advise parents not to be arranging too much or incurring great expense. Keep your preparations simple and low key. I will let you know as quickly as I can
