This applies when visiting the Nearly New Shop. This is open from 9am – 1pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday each week.

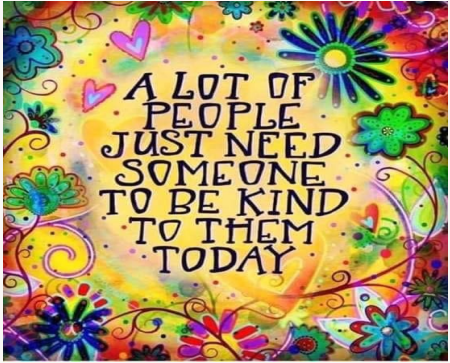
